



Our Approach to teaching.....

History

History is taught throughout school as part of Immersive Project Based Learning (PBL) rather than a discrete session.

The library is well resourced to support teaching and learning in history throughout school.

In KS1 and KS2 we use Cornerstones curriculum to support the planning of the new National Curriculum. We ensure a balance of projects to ensure at breadth and at least one PBL each year has a focus on history.

Some projects have a strong history focus such as 'Off with her head'. In projects such as these, history is delivered through literacy.

History in EYFS is planned and taught through EYFS objectives, particularly ones related to 'Understanding the World' and 'Peoples and Communities'. This is complimented through Cornerstones mini projects such as all about me and dinosaurs, which have history contents within. EYFS also use 'PLODS' (Possible Lines of Development) and follow children's interests to explore aspects of history. Observations and information gathered from pre-schools and home visits inform planning.
