AFTER SCHOOL CLUB SURVEY

Thank you to all the parents who returned the survey. We had a good overall response with most parents stating that they did not need After School provision.

There were some responses from parents who stated that it is needed. However, the number of children is too small to make it financial viable. Thursdays and Fridays were the most popular days with 12 or 13 children requiring the option to be picked up later than 3.15pm. This number fell to 10 on the other days.

To support parents, we are currently looking at the clubs after schools and possible options we can provide for F2 to Y6 children being able to access clubs on Thursday and Fridays every week. We will discuss this at the Parent and School Council
