Understanding the World	<ul> <li>QfL: What is the life cycle of a duck?</li> <li>Life cycle of a duck.</li> <li>Talk about what they can see up at forest school, what is different, what has changed?</li> <li>Vocabulary: life cycle, duck, duckling, mother, baby, egg, pip, hatch, crack, caring, incubate, incubator, brooder, beak, peck, waddle, wings, fluffy, webbed feet</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>QfL: Which things float? Which things sink?</li> <li>Exploring sinking and floating with a variety of objects in the water tray – forces</li> <li>Under the sea spot tray</li> <li>Vocabulary: float, sink, under, bottom, top, surface, slowly, quickly, water, heavy, light</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>QfL: How have I changed this year?</li> <li>Discuss pictures throughout the year, think about what we were like in September and how we have changed.</li> <li>Exploring pebbles, shells and rocks in spot tray.</li> <li>Vocabulary: change, growth, growing, older, remember, memories, year, achieved, knoweldge</li> </ul>
